1.	Good Living: Rental Advisory and Financial Education for Grassroots Communities	Comhome Social Housing Platform Limited	As housing pressure continues to rise, this project supports grassroots tenants in navigating an increasingly complex rental landscape. In addition to rental advisory services, it offers practical financial education to help tenants safeguard their rights, ease housing stress and build stronger financial resilience over time.
2.	SafeGuard: Debt and Scam Prevention Training for Migrant Caregivers	HELP Limited	For migrant domestic workers facing financial risks, this project offers practical support to safeguard their financial well-being. Going beyond traditional financial literacy, it combines early education on debt management and digital safety, integrated support for those in financial distress, and peer-led initiatives to strengthen long-term community resilience.
3.	NextGen Financial & Policy Ambassadors	The Boys' & Girls' Clubs Association of Hong Kong	Empowering young people to take charge of their financial future, this project equips secondary students through structured, experiential learning across personal finance, public finance, FinTech risk awareness and leadership development. As student ambassadors, participants share knowledge with peers and help promote stronger financial literacy within schools and the wider community.
4.	Know Money, Know Talk - Financial Education for At-risk Youth	Youth Outreach	For young people facing financial stress and social isolation, this project aims to create a pathway towards greater independence. Combining workshops, saving schemes, job shadowing and community engagement, it helps at-risk youth build practical money management and life planning skills for the future.

5.	Uplift Carer Network	Baptist Oi Kwan Social Service	Behind many families are caregivers who often feel unseen and unsupported. This project builds a district-based support model that mobilises community members to identify high-risk families caring for elderly members, reduce social isolation, and strengthen caregiving support within the community.
6.	Bridging Futures: Empowering Caregivers with Award-Winning AI to Support SEN Children	Bridge Foundation Limited	Access to timely support can make a meaningful difference for children with special educational needs. This project trains caregivers to deliver home-based support through structured training, clinical supervision and AI-enabled tools, expanding access to more affordable and timely services
7.	“Time Exchange” - Low-income Community Economy Project	Concern For Grassroots' Livelihood Alliance Limited	This project introduces a Time Bank platform that enables neighbours and organisations to exchange time through volunteering, creating new ways for communities to support one another while easing financial pressure.
8.	Equal Justice: Early Legal Support	Equal Justice Limited	Access to legal support is often unavailable to disadvantaged groups until legal issues have become increasingly complex or urgent. Access to legal support often comes too late for those who need it most. This project focuses on early intervention by providing timely legal information, caseworker training and referral pathways, helping disadvantaged communities navigate legal challenges with greater clarity.
9.	Be The Light - Community Counselling Training and Support Program	SCHOOL OF EVERYDAY LIFE LIMITED	Creating safe spaces for emotional support starts within the community. This project trains young facilitators to support peers with emotional needs, building a community-based network that strengthens mental well-being support for youth.
10.	“I’m Fine” - Smart Mental Health Resource Platform for Youth	The University of Hong Kong	Finding mental health support can often be overwhelming. This project brings together digital tools, service matching and a wide network of providers into one accessible platform, helping youth and their families connect to timely support.
